Prayer Letter December 2025

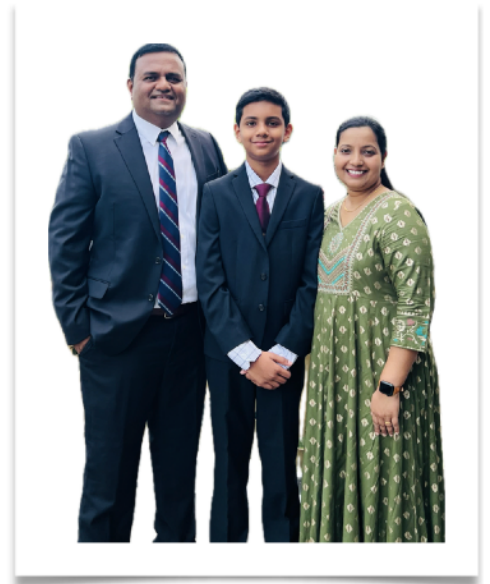
Dear Praying Partners in Christ,

*Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father,
and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Ephesians 1:2*

Thank you for your prayers and support throughout this year. God has been so good to us in keeping us faithful in every situation. And we would like to provide you with our ministry update.

Last month we celebrated our Amravati Baptist Church's 3rd anniversary. We had a wonderful celebration, glorifying God for His mercy on us. We distributed gifts to the faithful people of the church and took them out for lunch. Though people here may never understand the value of a church in their life, we know how important it is to have a church which teaches the truth to a dying community and city. It was the Lord's mercy to the people in this part of India to start His church that many would hear the glorious gospel of Jesus Christ and might get saved.

Since I was saved, I always had a tremendous burden for my grandparents who were in their 90's. They were "Christian" but never had a salvation testimony and were relying on their good works for their salvation. I tried witnessing to them multiple times but they never listened. My grandmother, due to some illness, came to Amravati to stay with my mother. We prayed for her, witnessed to her again, and tried to explain her lost condition to her. One Sunday, before church,



she asked me a question: "If I set everything I am trusting on aside, then what is it that can save me, what am I missing?" I knew God was working on her heart and though I was trying to explain to her, she could not understand without God opening her understanding. Two days later, on November the 4th, I went to talk to her, and on a whiteboard, explained her lost and sinful condition and explained to her the gospel. On that day she prayed and accepted Christ as her personal savior.

That was the last day and hour when she was able to talk well and see, because immediately after that day, she was diagnosed with cancer, fell severely ill and died only one month later. The photo I am sharing is the last time she smiled after accepting Christ. My dear friends, this is a wonderful testimony that we should never give up on our unsaved family and friends, our merciful God is surely going to answer our prayers in His time. Amen.

And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. Galatians 6:9

God also gave me the opportunity to preach the gospel at her funeral where so many unsaved people were present.

To disciple new believers, I have started working on translating the "First Steps For New Christians" discipleship course into Marathi, which is our local language. I was only going to do the few lesson, but soon God gave me the wisdom to translate and print the entire 13 lesson book into Marathi and distribute them to other churches where many are not saved. Our idea here is to distribute them as discipleship courses and encourage them to read so that they can compare their salvation with the Word of God, and pray that many will get saved by reading the truth.

I have already translated 10 lessons and am working on the remaining. Please pray that God will bless this effort, and that it will be a huge tool to bring many church going people to Christ. Please also pray that God would lead me in it's translating, formatting, printing, and distribution. We need God's blessing on this as I see this having a tremendous potential to reach many people.

I also created a Marathi Bible reading plan for 2026 and will be sharing it with the church to encourage and help them read their Bibles.

During the last three months, God gave me a plenty of opportunities to witness one on one, to many family members, friends, strangers, blind people, drunkards, and many daily wage and construction workers. I cannot write everyone's details, but I would especially like to tell you about one person named Narendra, who sells all Christian materials outside every church in this area. I invited him to my house to purchase some Hindi bibles, and after the initial talk, I questioned him about his eternity, which made him uncomfortable. I then gave him the gospel. He prayed and trusted Jesus Christ for his salvation.

Later I gave him a plenty of Marathi and Hindi gospel tracts and asked him to give to every person who purchases any items from you. He agreed and said that he may not be able to talk and share the gospel like I did to him, but he can certainly give gospel tracts to others.

Family update.

Yohan, our son is growing in the Lord. He recently memorized Hebrews 11. It was a joy to see his love for the Word of God. He is also growing in height, as at the age of 13, he is almost as tall as me. Please keep him in your prayers.

My wife's health is also doing well, and please keep her Children's ministry in your prayers. Pray that parents would send their kids to Sunday School, and that she would be able to lead many kids to Christ.

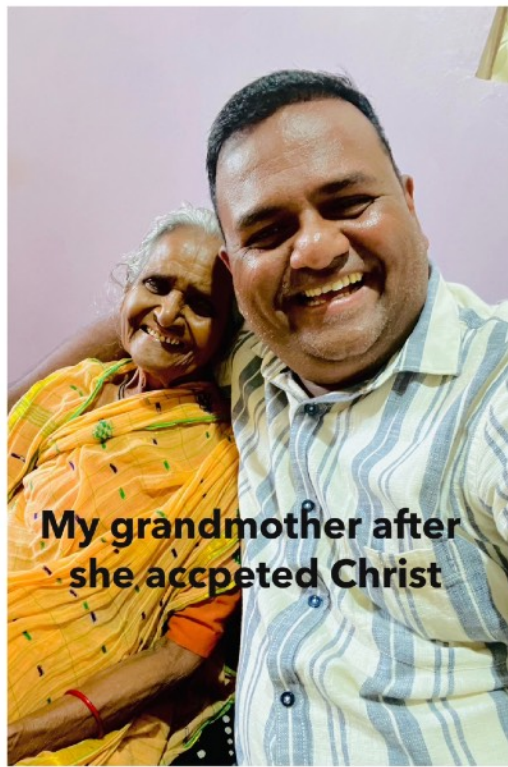
Our house construction is progressing and it may take 6-8 more months to complete the construction. Please pray for God's provision.

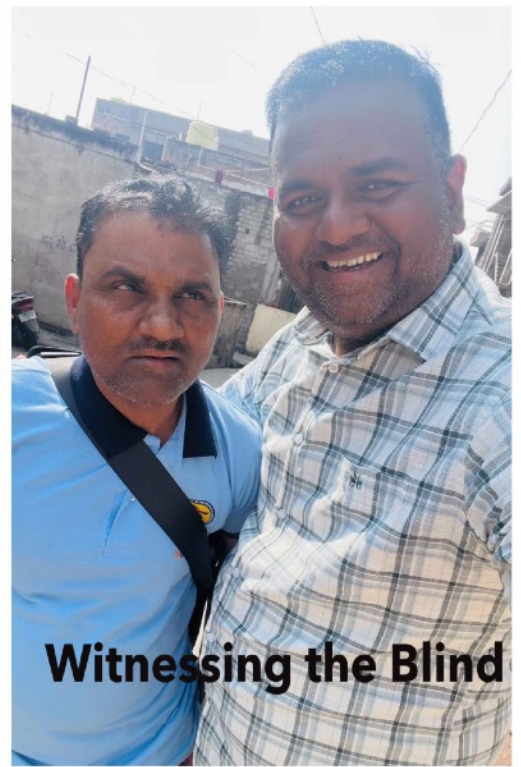
